According to the provisions of *ITB 8 – Amendment of Bidding Document*, the Bidding Document is hereby amended as follows:

Article 2. The provisions of clause no. ITB 16.4 under Section II – Bid Data Sheet (BDS) is hereby **modified** and shall be read as specified in the column “Revised – Amendment no. 1 to the RFB – 06/RFB/2025”:

<p>Period of time the Goods are expected to be functioning (for the purpose of spare parts): 5 years after the end of the warranty period.</p> <p>The Bidder must also furnish a statement of availability of the spare parts necessary for the proper and continuing functioning of the Goods for a period of 5 years after the end of the warranty period.</p> <p>The costs related to spare parts, accessories and consumables will be paid by the final beneficiaries of the mobile inspection centers during the warranty period and post-warranty period.</p>	<p>Period of time the Goods are expected to be functioning (for the purpose of spare parts): 10 years for the utility van 5 years for the other goods</p> <p>The Bidder must also furnish a statement of availability of the spare parts necessary for the proper and continuing functioning of the Goods for a period of 10 years for the utility van and 5 years for the other goods, following commencement of the use of the utility van and of the other goods by the Purchaser.</p> <p>The costs related to spare parts and workmanship needed for the remediation of any defects during the warranty period, will be covered by the warranty and supported by the supplier.</p> <p>During the warranty period and post-warranty period, the costs related to other spare parts and consumables will be paid by the final beneficiaries of the mobile inspection centers.</p>



Article 3. The provisions of point no. 3.1 Qualification Criteria (ITB 37.1) under Section III – Evaluation and Qualification Criteria, **paragraph i)**, is hereby **modified** and shall be read as specified in the column “Revised – Amendment no. 1 to the RFB – 06/RFB/2025”:

The Bidder or its authorized Agent(s) must be equipped and able to carry out the warranty services (24 months from the date of signing the reception protocol for the completion of related services) /after sales services and spare parts-stocking prescribed in the Conditions of Contract and/or Technical Specifications or the Bidder must prove that will be represented in Romania by an authorized Agent or will present letter of intent or pre-agreement with a local agent/s for provision of after sales services. [...]	The Bidder or its authorized Agent(s) must be equipped and able to carry out the warranty services (minimum 36 months for the Utility Van and minimum 24 months for the other goods), from the date of signing the reception protocol for the completion of related services) as well as the after sales/ post-warranty services and spare parts-stocking prescribed in the Conditions of Contract and/or Technical Specifications for a period of at least 3 years after the end of the warranty period , or the Bidder must prove that will be represented in Romania by an authorized Agent or will present letter of intent or pre-agreement with a local agent/s for provision of after sales services. Article 4. The provisions of clause no. GCC 28.3 under Section IX – Special Conditions of Contract, is hereby modified and shall be read as specified in the column “Revised – Amendment no. 1 to the RFB – 06/RFB/2025”:

Article 5. All other clauses and provisions of Request for Bids no. 06/RFB/2025, that are not amended as per the articles above shall remain valid and unchanged.
